Louisiana Revised Statute 42:5.1. School board meetings; public comment

Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, each school board subject to the provisions of this Chapter shall allow public comment at any meeting of the school board prior to taking any vote. The comment period shall be for each agenda item and shall precede each agenda item. A comment period for all comments at the beginning of a meeting shall not suffice as a comment period. *Added by Acts 1997, No. 895, § 1, eff. July 10, 1997.*
